"There will be Share-Our-Wealth Societies for everyone to meet. They have a great work to perform... Let us be about our work... There is enough for all... Beautiful America can rise to the opportunity before it. It means to us all: Every man a king." (Senator Long in a coast-to-coast broadcast, May 2, 1935.)
